






Cut the side tracks (c-channels) to size with a hacksaw. Align each side track to header track and sill track. Install side tracks using 5-6 #6x1" screws per track.




NOTE: For Jamb widths between 4-9/16" and 5-1/2", add a ½" x 1" Spacer (not supplied) to the vertical Brickmold edge. This will fill the gap between the C-Channel and the Brickmold. The Spacer provides secure mounting for the C-Channel screws. (shown at right)



For a double patio unit with one swinging door, one side track is installed to a jamb (brickmold for 4-9/16" jamb unit). For triple patio unit with one swinging door, depending on the configuration, side track may be installed on a mullion cap or a side jamb (brickmold for 4-9/16" jamb unit). For the above patio units with single swinging door, screen door is installed on the outer track.

For each screen door, install the top end of the screen door to the header track as shown above. Then position the bottom end of the screen to the sill track. Make sure that the bug seal is facing the interior side.

5 Raise and level the screen door about 1/8" off the sill by adjusting the bottom rollers as shown in the figure at right. Do not over-tightened the screw. When screen doors are installed, make sure that bug seals are making a good seal at mullion or with inner screen door in case of a french door.
